Section <u>627.668</u>, Florida Statutes, requires insurers of group health plans to make available to the policyholder (e.g., employer, association) as part of the application, for an appropriate additional premium, under a hospital and medical expense-incurred insurance policy, under a prepaid health care contract, and under a hospital and medical service plan contract, coverage for mental and nervous disorders.
